

REFLECTION on the GOSPEL

"Christmas in July" is a particular annual event that TV Shopping channels use to push products for the season five months out. So I am told by my sisters who are much aware of such. A clever idea for sure, perhaps even calculated to provide at least some imaginary relief from the heat and humidity of the present month.

That idea of Christmas sales led me to think of a popular movie of that season called "It's a Wonderful Life." That 1946 classic featured a despicable character known as Mr. Potter, played with panache by the late Lionel Barrymore. You most likely know him as the antagonist of Jimmy Stewart's character George Bailey, the hero of the story.

One critic of the film calls it in actuality, a "dark film." He writes, in part: "It's a magical realist conceit, able to strike directly into the purpose of human existence and remind everyone that they're special for who they are." But he continues: "Yet we have to wade through the unrelentingly destructive forces of capitalism...the reminder that all people around you get to succeed while you do not..." All well and good as analysis.

For my purpose, I'd like to focus on Mr. Potter, who represents materialism in charge. He is always miserable, "speechifying" with a harsh and cynical voice. You get the unavoidable impression that for all his wealth, Potter is not a happy person. Joyless in the extreme.

Our Lord could well use Mr. Potter as an example of what He meant in His always masterful stories like the one about the "rich man whose land produced a bountiful harvest." Note how Our Lord's character goes past Mr. Potter by saying to himself "Rest, eat, drink, be merry." But then comes God's response, a unique powerful retort: "You fool!"

I believe we have been given powerful food for thought as we have sat in our favorite comfy chair and watched on our large screens the beautiful faith-filled reaction of the Ukrainian people to the evil foisted on them by Russia. With nothing more than the clothes on their backs and a small sack of family mementos, they have retained their hope and dream of victory. They have their faith in God intact and their trust in Him solid. Not based on accumulated possessions. It is the ones with the multi-million-dollar yachts who are trapped by a poisoned outlook that is far from a truly wonderful life. So, today we relearn the hard lesson that trusting in our possessions as a source of happiness is as foolish as...well, "Christmas in July." Put another way is this analogy from an anonymous source: "Riches are a golden key that opens every door, save that of heaven."

From the Pastor

Saint. Alphonsus Liguori: a Gentle Shepherd – St. Alphonsus was born in 1696 in Italy and died in 1787. His feast day is August 1. He is especially remembered as a great moral theologian. He explained the faith and the moral demands of discipleship in simple language that spoke to the hearts of his people. He helped people understand how to express their faith in their everyday actions. His counsels for living were marked by moderation and gentleness. He called people to fidelity to our Lord but preached the great mercy of God for our failings and shortcomings. He preached many parish missions that helped rejuvenate the faith of the people. He inspired them to believe in God's forgiveness and renew their love for Jesus and the way of daily Christian discipleship. He founded the Redemptorist Religious Order and after many difficulties the Order flourished. St. John Neumann was a member of this religious community.

Saint John Vianney: Patron Saint of Parish Priests – St. John Vianney was born in 1786 and died in 1859. His feast day is August 4. After many struggles with completing the academic requirements for the priesthood, John was ordained a priest and assigned to the Parish in the town of Ars. His holy life and dedication helped to reform many of the people in the town. He became known as a great confessor and soon attracted many people to Ars to receive the Sacrament of Penance and renew their commitment to living their Catholic faith. He spent many hours in the confessional each day. He is the patron saint of all parish priests. Please pray for me and all parish priests. Through the intercession of St. John Vianney may we be ardent, holy and gentle shepherds of the people entrusted to our care.

Evening Prayer and Adoration in the Mary Garden on Monday, August 15, Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary into Heaven – This Solemnity falls on a Monday this year, so it is not a holyday of obligation. To mark this special day we will celebrate Evening Prayer and have adoration of the Blessed Sacrament in the Mary Garden at 7:00 pm. Come and join us in giving honor to our Blessed Mother.

CHURCH TEACHING

The Eucharistic Revival is a three-year period of helping people to grow in their understanding of and appreciation for the celebration of the Eucharist. This Revival has been called for by the bishops of the United States and began on June 19, the Solemnity of the Holy Body and Blood of Christ. As part of this effort to help you learn more about the Mass and participate more fully in it, I am including in the Bulletin each week a brief teaching on the Eucharist from a document entitled "The Mystery of the Eucharist in the Life of the Church," which was prepared by the bishops to guide the Revival.

Church Teaching: The Saving Work of Christ Made Present – The saving work of Jesus Christ, which has brought to fulfillment what was announced in figure in the Passover, is now re-presented in the celebration of the Eucharist. The Eucharist makes present the one sacrifice of Christ the Savior. As Pope St. John Paul II taught: "The Church constantly draws her life from this redeeming sacrifice; she approaches it not only through faith-filled remembrance, but also through a real contact, since this sacrifice is made present ever anew, sacramentally perpetuated, in every community which offers it at the hands of the consecrated minister.

ANOINTING OF THE SICK

In case of serious illness, please contact the Rectory to make arrangements. If someone is already in the hospital, be sure to register as a Catholic so that the priest will visit.

COMMUNION CALLS

Parishioners unable to attend Mass regularly because of age or illness should call the Rectory to make arrangements to receive Communion at home. If any member of your family is hospitalized, please be sure to register as a Catholic and inform the Rectory so that a visit can be arranged.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on Sundays at 12:30 PM. Arrangements must be made in advance at the Rectory by calling Msgr. Dougherty, ext. 12. If parents have not attended a Baptism class, they must attend our Baptism Preparation Seminar. Call the rectory to register for the class. Godparents guidelines state that one godparent must be Catholic. They must be at least 16 years of age, registered in the parish where they live, fully initiated, and practicing their faith; they must obtain a letter of eligibility from their own parish. One practicing non-Catholic Christian may also be admitted as a Christian Witness. **[The next Baptism Preparation Seminar is Thursday, August 18 2022, at 7:00pm in the Rectory.](#)**

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Registered parishioners who wish to marry at St. Margaret should contact Msgr. Dougherty. The Sacrament of Marriage is celebrated after a period of preparation of not less than six months. Therefore, anyone requesting a certificate must be a registered, participating member of St. Margaret Parish, a practicing Catholic in good standing (not living in violation of the church laws), at least 16 years of age and have received the sacraments of initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist). 
